“You have heard that it was said, ‘Do not commit adultery.’ But I tell you that anyone who looks at a woman lustfully has already committed adultery with her in his heart. If your right eye causes you to sin, gouge it out and throw it away. It is better for you to lose one part of your body than for your whole body to be thrown into hell. And if your right hand causes you to sin, cut it off and throw it away. It is better for you to lose one part of your body than for your whole body to go into hell.”

### The Territory That Must Be Won (vv. 27-28)

Most of us are familiar with the \_\_\_\_\_ battlefield.

Hebrews 13:4 (NIV), “God will judge the adulterer and all the sexually immoral.”

Jesus tells us to bring the fight right into the \_\_\_\_\_ battlefield of our thought life.

### The Sacrifice That Must Be Made (vv. 29-30)

Practical Suggestions:

1. Don't put yourself in \_\_\_\_\_ way. “I noticed . . . a youth who lacked judgement. He was going down the street near her corner, walking along in the direction of her house at twilight, as the day was fading, as the dark of night set in” (Proverbs 7:7-9, NIV).

2. Replace your \_\_\_\_\_ for that which is fallen with a desire to discover the richness of God and His ways. “I want you to be wise about what is good, and innocent about what is evil” (Romans 16:19, NIV).

3. Pray for the \_\_\_\_\_ of the Spirit. “The one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world. (1John 4:4, NIV).

4. Make yourself \_\_\_\_\_. “Two are better than one . . . If one falls down, his friend can help him up. But pity the man who falls and has no one to help him up!” (Ecclesiastes 4:9-10, NIV).
