- First agree with God about the sin.
- Second, turn from the sin and seek God's forgiveness.
- Third, take whatever steps you can to correct the consequences left behind by your failure.
- Walk in integrity from this point forward.

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➤ SAVOR IT (all week long)**

Last week you explored Jesus' teachings on integrity. These passages and questions will serve to reinforce those truths and motivate you to firmly establish them in your Christian walk.

Monday, May 14: Read Job 2:3-9, (p. 614-DSB*). What did God say about Job's integrity? How did God feel about Job because of his integrity? What confidence did God place in Job? What did Job's wife say to him? What does this tell you about Job's integrity?

Tuesday, May 15: Read Titus 2:7-10, (p.1604-DSB*). What is the connection between integrity and an effective witness to the world? Are you a reluctant or a ready witness for Christ? How would a lack of integrity affect a Christian's willingness to be open and transparent with their faith?

Wednesday, May 16: Read Isaiah 59:4-15, (p. 952-DSB*). How does God feel about a society that operates with a lack of integrity or honesty? How would you rate the people you deal with on a daily basis in these areas? How would your rate yourself as an example of honesty and integrity?

Thursday, May 17: Read Acts 5:3-6, (p. 1441-DSB*). Based on what happened, how does God view honesty in His followers? Does this principle apply only to offerings? How would you apply it to your home life? Business life?

Friday, May 18: Read Psalm 15, (p. 671-DSB*). Who can expect to walk closely with God? How do you measure up to verses 3-5? What do you need to do?
